PUBLIC NOTICE

Inviting Suggestions / Objections on The Tata Power Company Limited's Application for Fourth amendment of its Transmission Licence No.1 of 2014

(Case No. 13 of 2024)

- 1. The Tata Power Company Limited-Transmission Business (TPC-T) has filed an Application for Fourth amendment of its Transmission Licence No. 1 of 2014 before the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC) under the provisions of Section 18 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 39 of the MERC (Transaction of Business and Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2022 and MERC (Transmission Licence Conditions) Regulations, 2004. The Commission has admitted the Application on 22 April 2024 and directed Tata Power-T to publish a Public Notice under Section 18 (2) of the Act.
- The Transmission Licence No. 1 of 2014 under Section 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 granted to TPC-T as amended from time to time is Line and Bay specific. The Licence requires amendment on account of commissioning/decommissioning/modification to the Transmission Lines and Bays post grant of the Licence.
- The STU vide its report dated 28 February 2024 has verified the assets as proposed for the amendment.
- Rationale for proposed alteration or amendment of transmission licence:
 - a) Amendment proposed to the Existing Transmission lines -
 - > Transmission Line in the "Proposed List of Transmission Lines" to be shifted to "Existing Transmission Lines" in the Transmission Licence post its commissioning,
 - Addition / Removal of Transmission Line to / from Existing Transmission Lines,
 - > Changes in Transmission Line Length after replacement of old oil filled cables.
 - b) Amendment proposed to the Existing Transmission Bays -
 - Transmission Bays in the "Proposed List of Bays" to be shifted to "Existing Bays at Sub-Stations" in the Transmission Licence post its commissioning,
 - Addition / Removal of Bays with respect to / from the existing Transmission Licence,
 - Transfer of bays from Generation Business of Tata Power which are serving the purpose of transmission of electricity.
 - c) Amendment proposed to "Proposed List of Bays" and "Proposed List of Transmission lines"
 - Update in "Proposed List of Bays" and "Proposed List of Transmission lines" due to its respective shifting to "Existing Bays at Sub-Stations" and "Existing Transmission Lines" post-commissioning.
 - Update with respect to new developments proposed in the transmission network in line with the current STU Five-Year plan for FY 2022-23 to FY 2026-27,
 - Update with respect to schemes proposed for reliability improvement and power supply to new consumers schemes which are not part of updated STU Five-Year plan for FY 2022-23 to FY 2026-27 but in the advanced stage of inclusion in the upcoming 5 year STU plan.

- TPC-T shall reply to each of the objections /comments received within three days of the
 receipt of the same but not later than 27 May 2024 for all the objections/comments received
 till 24 May 2024.
